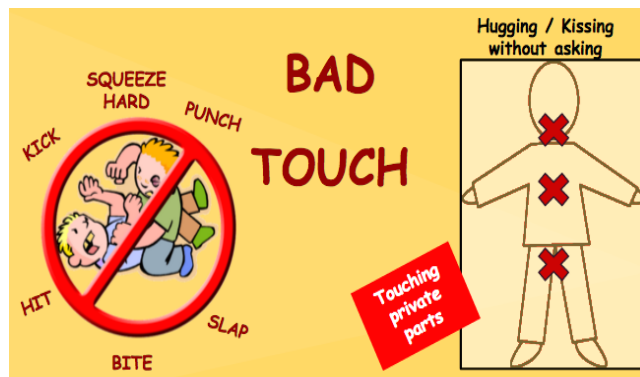

A good touch is something that makes us feel happy.

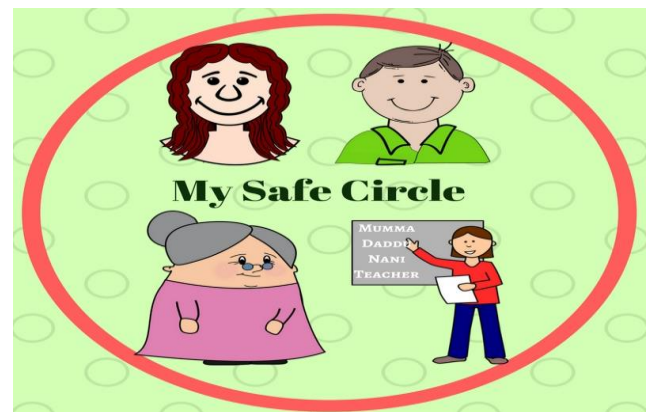


What is Bad touch?

Indoor play area in LIS

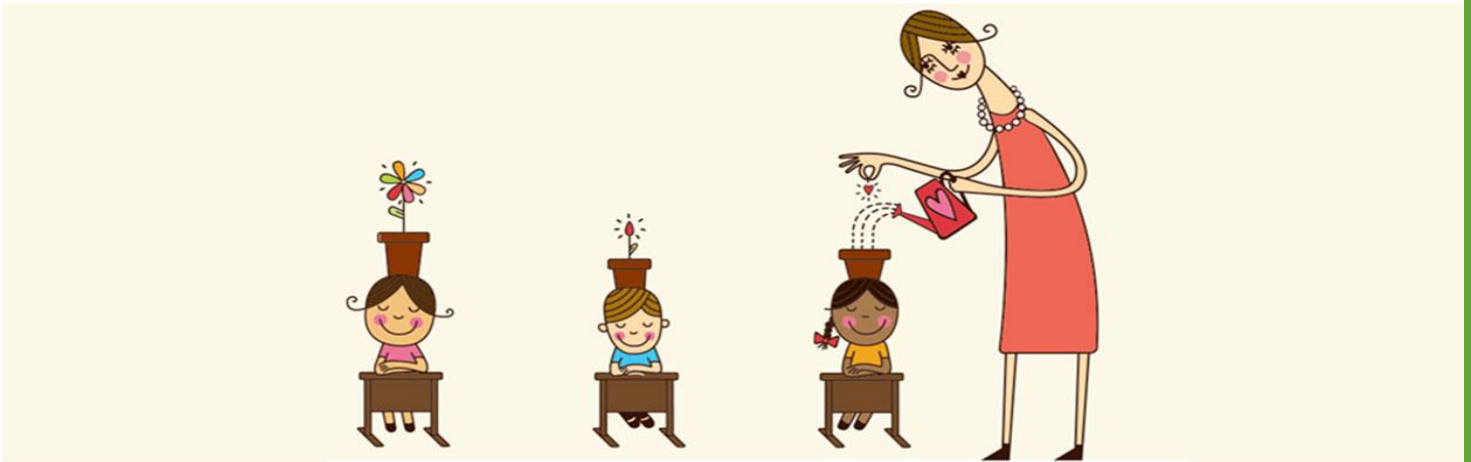
When your kids are looking for fun games & activities to play at school with friends inside, they could try any of these games.
