## Students Well Being

What actually students' well-being means?

Students' individual well-being is a result of their interaction with their environment, the material resources they have access to, and students' responses to external opportunities and stress factors. No ways, it has been observed that students experience less disciplinary incidents, can concentrate better on academics, and develop stronger communication skills, when schools foster emotional well-being. This can lead to greater academic performance and lifelong health. We at LIS focus on overall development of a individual child.so far that various activities were planned out like Fancy dress competition

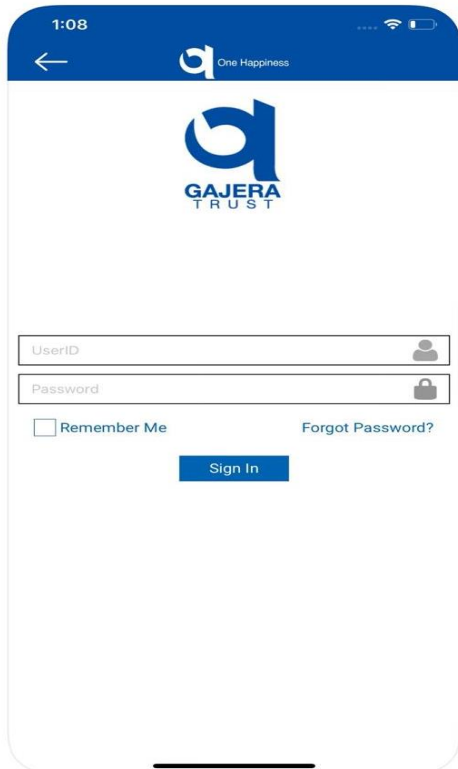
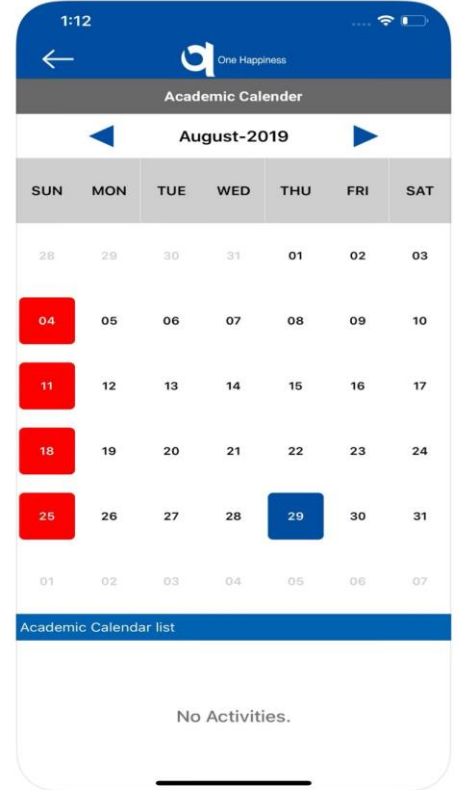
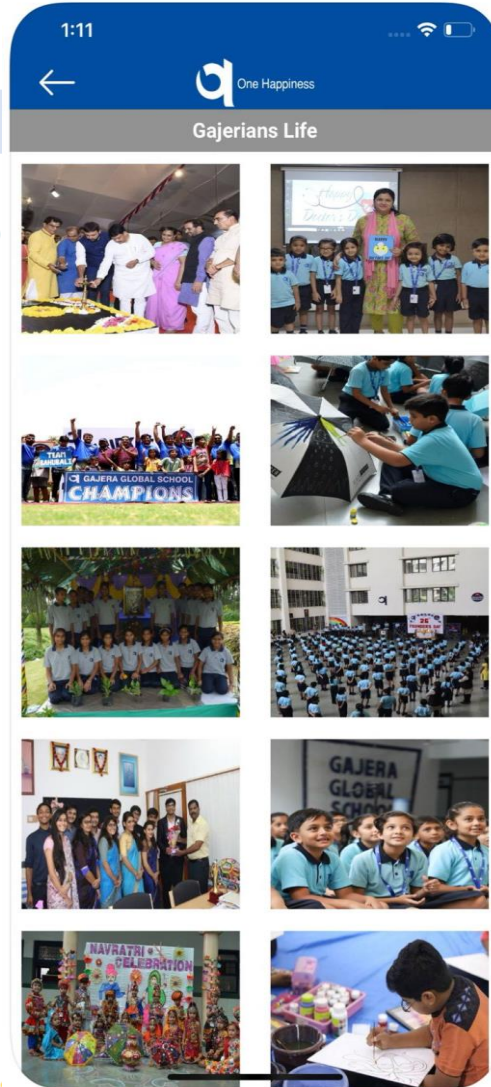
