The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is the <u>youth wing</u> of the <u>Indian Armed Forces</u> with its headquarters in <u>New Delhi, India</u>. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis as a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the <u>Army</u>, <u>the Navy</u> and <u>the Air Force</u>, engaged in developing the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The soldier youth foundation in India is a voluntary organization which recruits cadets from <u>high schools</u>, higher secondary, <u>colleges</u> and <u>universities</u> all over India. The cadets are given basic military training in small arms and drill. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course.

In the CATCs, the boys (senior and junior divisions) and girl cadets (senior and junior wings) of a particular NCC unit participate in the 10-day camp. Classes are conducted as per the given syllabus wherein certain aspects of NCC training are taught once again. The camp acts as a refresher training for the cadets and they are also trained in basic skills of survival and emergencies besides other topics.

SERVER ROOM

LIS has server room located in I.T hub server room, also known as a data center or computer room, is a dedicated space within a building or facility that is designed to house and operate computer servers and other related equipment.

Server room are enclosed spaces that provide a central point for organizations to manage their network server resources. The design of these environments must take into consideration network connectivity and

power, room temperature control and ventilation, room and rack security, and fire and seismic protection.

A server room provides the operational and environmental components and services to operate enterprise class servers. Generally, a server room might include 10 to several hundred servers. The servers housed in a server room usually include basic CPU components. A server room is a room used to store, power and operate computer servers and their associate components.
