I believe that creating inclusive learning environment is essential for the success of all students, but especially those with special needs. I strive to create a positive and supportive classroom atmosphere where students with special needs feel confident and respected. To do this, I interact with class teachers and subject teachers and we together make sure that these special students do not feel alienated. When assessing a student's individual needs, I always begin by gathering as information as possible. This includes conducting interviews with parents, teachers and other professionals, observing the student in their environment, using assessments. Once I have this information, I use it to develop an IEP that meets the student's individual needs. I ensure the plan is tailored to the student and regularly measure progress against the goals outlined in the IEP.

The school's enthusiastic principal, Mr. Pravin Pawar believed that such an event would not only promote physical fitness but also bring the community together.






NEW HAPPENINGS






CCA/CCE / CLUBS
